TNB to acquire 20 pct MRCB's stakes in fibrecomm network

KUALA LUMPUR Feb 14 - Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) has proposed to acquire the entire 20 percent equity interest of Fibrecomm Network (M) Sdn Bhd from Malaysian Resources Corporation Bhd (MRCB).

In line with this, TNB has entered into an agreement for the sales and purchase of shares with MRCB on Feb 9, 2002, TNB said.

In a statement to the Kuala Lumpur Stock Exchange (KLSE) here today, TNB said that the proposed acquisition involved the purchase of 15 million shares for a cash consideration of RM22 million.

It said that the proposed exercise would allow TNB to increase its stake to 59 percent from 39 percent in Fibrecomm.

TNB said that as Fibrecomm networks were installed on TNB's electricity infrastructure and premises, it was important for the company to have control over the network.

The proposed acquisition is expected to be completed by June 2002.

Fibrecomm is a joint venture company between TNB, MRCB and Celcom. Its core business is in the provision of telecommunication network service over TNB's power infrastructure.

The company currently owns and operates an extensive 98,000 fibre kilometers of networks and offers a wide range of products and services, including connectivity, bandwidth and other network facilities to its shareholder and service providers in the information and communications technology (ICT) industry.

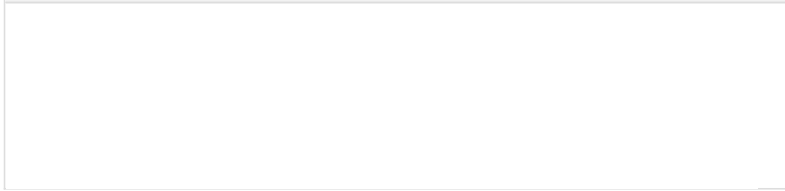

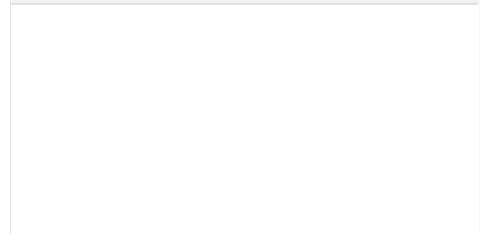
